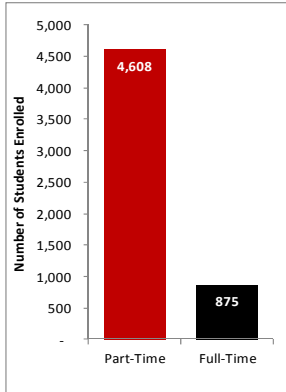


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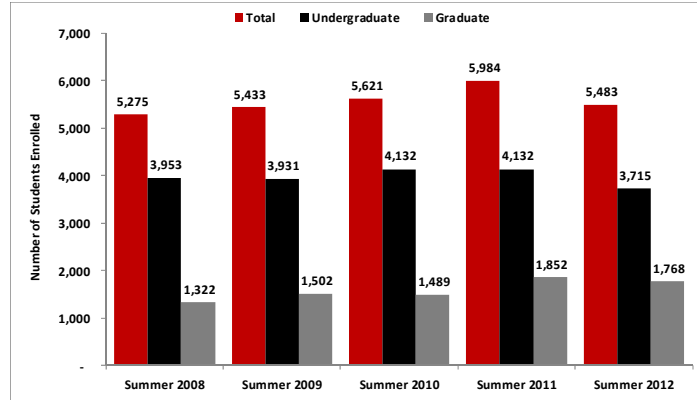

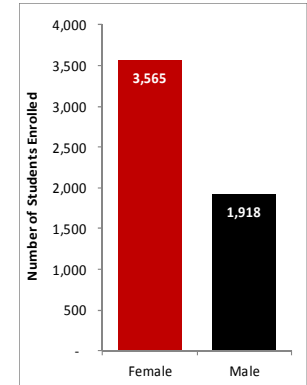
Enrollment by Time Status, Summer 2012



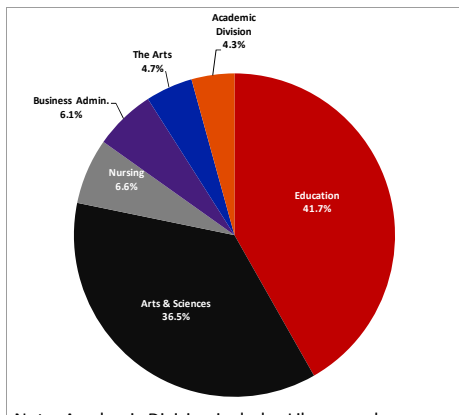
Total Enrollment, Summer 2008–Summer 2012

Total Enrollment by College, Summer 2012

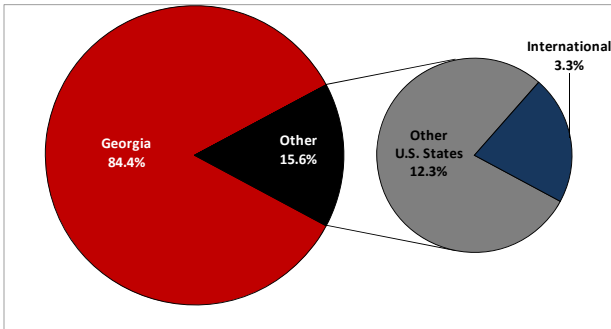

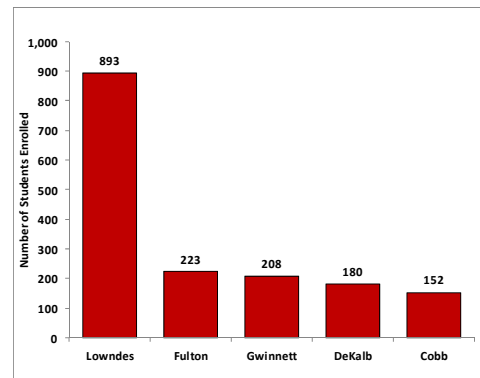

Total Enrollment by Origin, Summer 2012



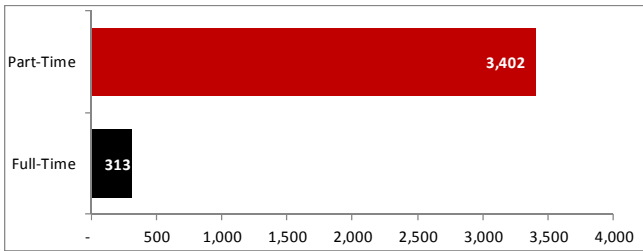

Five Georgia Counties with the Most Enrollees, Summer 2012



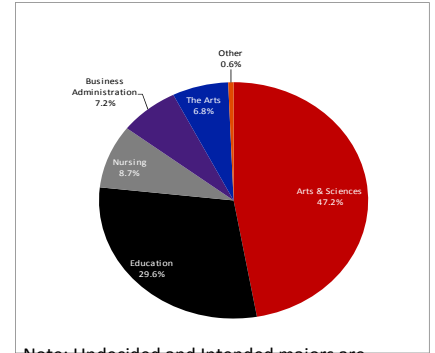

Undergraduate Enrollment by Time Status



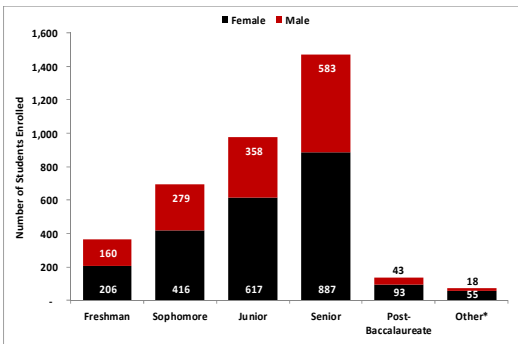

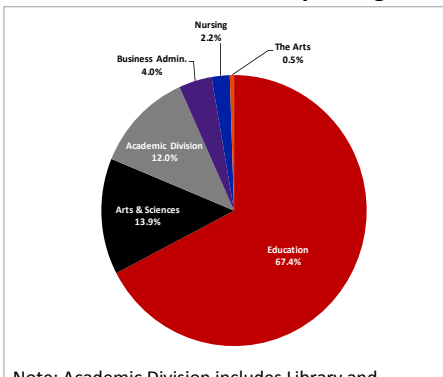

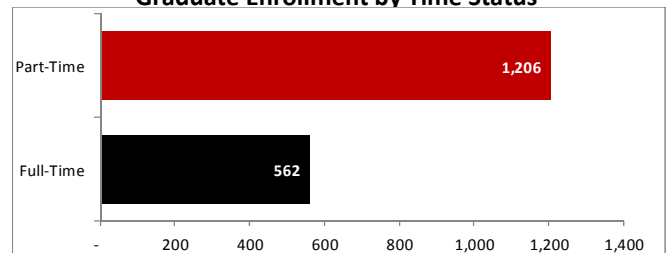
Graduate Enrollment by College

Graduate Enrollment by Time Status

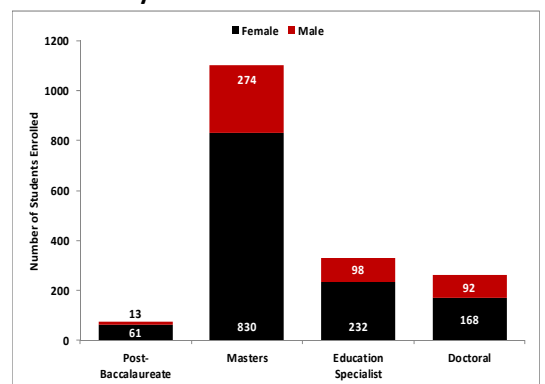
